



RoanAtti's World Environment Day - '350ppm Campaign'

On 5th June, Raonatti - the 5th batch members and the returnees in Korea jointly organized '350ppm campaign' to celebrate this year's World Environment Day (WED). Although, the format of campaigns and programs were different from region to region, Raonatti had meaningful moments calling for action to participate in '350ppm campaign' in their local community and celebrating the WED. We would like to share Raonatti's actions carried out in 7 Asian countries.

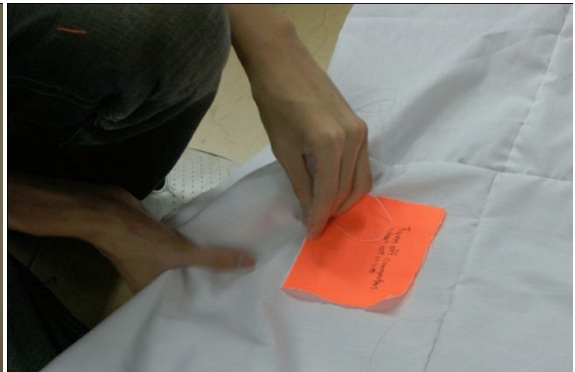
1. Malaysia

Raonatti members and Kuala Lumpur YMCA organized promotion activities on '350ppm campaign' for local people who visited at YMCA and made placards and banners by hand printing. Also, they joined street campaign and walking around their neighborhoods explaining the purpose and importance of 350ppm campaign.



2. Vietnam

Raonatti members participated in the Work Camp with Singaporean Youths at Mekong Delta region. On the first day of event, they had seminar on '350ppm campaign'. During the session, participants wrote down their daily action plan on how to achieve '350ppm' and stitched their memos into big banners. After the seminar, they had photos times and celebrated the WED.



3. Sri Lanka

Sri Lanka team members and Moratuwa YMCA organized the '350ppm campaign' with local youths and children members of Moratuwa YMCA. The main activities were to understand the meaning of '350ppm' and they had collective tree planting activities around the village.



4. Cambodia

Raonatti members organized street promotion activities for foreign travelers, local youths and children around Da-il community center. They made banners and placard explaining the purpose of this event and had photos with locals who showed deep interest. The members had meaningful moment calling for action and celebrating the WED.



5. Thailand

Thailand team members and students at Pangnamtu Elementary school which Raonatti members are staying these days organized a Mango tree planting activities. Although, there are quite many other trees already available around the school, students were excited to hear that their actions can make cleaner atmosphere. Also, they showed big expectation to pick mangos at school in the future. After the program, they had photo time with 350ppm banners.





6. Philippines

Raonatti members and Nueva Ecija YMCA youth members organized '350ppm campaign' together. They had street campaign with banners and placard saying "one climate, one future, one chance, Let's go back to 350". Also, participants came together to make 'tree of hope' to ensure better environment by writing down their promises. Lastly, they made and uploaded the video clip of singing a song about global warming. The lyrics were changed from the original song 'Change the world'.

7. Korea

Raonatti returnees had the workshop on 28 May to prepare '350ppm campaign' for WED. The theme of the workshop was 'Nabi Hyo-Kwa, Naye Hyo-kwa' (butterfly effect, my effect) and its purpose was to bring our concerns together and discuss about how our daily routine action can affect the whole environment. On the WED, Raonatti returnees collected trash, empty boxes, used banners and posters from the city and the university area. With those materials, they made '350ppm' placards and artworks and installed them in Chung-gye stream where a large crowds moves around. After that, they were divided into 6 groups along jong-ro street (Main Street of Seoul) for street promotion activities and they started 'Let's walk if it is just a two metro station away to reduce CO2 emission!' campaign.
